Job Purpose

As a Casual Funeral Operative, you will play a vital role in the practical and compassionate delivery of our services. You'll assist with our on-call duties during evenings and weekends, ensuring every family receives exceptional care and support when they need it most. While experience in the funeral industry is not required, we are looking for individuals who are keen to make a positive difference in their local community.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Attending private homes, care homes and the hospice alongside a full-time team member;
- Safely and respectfully bring people into our care out of hours;
- Support the coroner's work when required, including rota-based and family-request duties;
- Assist the team in bringing people into our care from local and national hospitals during office hours;
- Maintain company vehicles to a high standard, ensuring they are clean, well-stocked and ready for every call-out.

Working conditions

This flexible, casual role involves covering our out-of-hours service from 5pm to 9am on weekdays and rotational weekend shifts with the team.

Physical requirements

The role is physically demanding and requires the ability to lift and carry heavy weights in accordance with manual handling procedures. In some situations, such as narrow or restricted spaces, the use of a wheeled stretcher may not be possible.

Requirements

- Must be comfortable working in an environment where death, its associated odours, challenging sights, and other distressing elements may be regularly encountered.
- Demonstrates empathy, professionalism and composure at all times;
- Physically able to perform heavy lifting duties safely;
- Works effectively as part of a small team in a family business environment;
- Flexible with unpredictable call-out schedules and durations;
- Reliable, well-presented, and committed to high standards;
- Familiar with the local community;
- Dedicated to delivering exceptional customer service;
- Holds a full, valid UK driving licence.
