9. provide you with a full breakdown of costs as soon as we receive your instructions that resembles the final invoice unless a mutually agreed change has taken place.
10. keep accurate records and ensure all staff are aware of your instructions.
11. encourage and welcome constructive criticism, positive feedback or complaints in order to continually improve our service.
